Northside Church of Christ Elders:

In 1989 Christian Heritage Schools was not afforded the opportunity to renew our lease with Alamo Heights for our location at Robbins Elementary School. At the time, Northside Church of Christ had 6 acres behind the church building that was virtually land locked. Northside graciously allowed us to build a campus on the 6 acres. What a blessing that was for CHS. Jim Calle, an engineer and George Vaughn, an architect, immediately went to work to design the campus. They volunteered their time and did such a great job in a short period of time. As we continued to need more space, other buildings were added. The gymnasium and the Preschool building were built by CHS. These buildings have been shared by both Northside and CHS.

When Northside decided to move to a new location, they met with the CHS board and offered CHS the opportunity to move with them to their new location. Much thought, discussion and prayers went into the decision as to the pros and cons of moving the school. The move would require CHS to raise several hundred thousand dollars for incremental cost to build classrooms and required facilities in the Northside Church building. This would be extremely difficult since many of the people we would need to donate are not members of the church of Christ. In addition, there were concerns that a high percentage of our students and possibly some teachers would not move to the new location. The church location is very close to San Antonio Christian School. However, the primary feeling with the CHS Board was that it was time for us to work toward securing our own campus. This year is the 30th anniversary for CHS and this is the best location for the campus. This will always be a good property due to the 281 frontage.


We are presently working on a presentation to communicate our plans with those who desire to help.

We sincerely feel there is a time in God's plan for things to happen, and we are convinced this is the time for CHS. We recognize this will take much work, and we are prepared to work toward that end.

Nothing worthwhile happens without work and without God's assistance all the way. We are proud of the students and the work that is being done at CHS; we truly feel it is a successful mission field.

Again, we thank you for working with us these 18 years. It has been a good relationship and without you, we can only imagine what would have happened. We do appreciate you very much and thank you for all you have done for CHS. Our wish is that God will bless you in your new location and that He will bless CHS as we continue to work toward purchasing this property.
